I, Erez Ashkenazy, after being first duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

1. I am employed by Camtek, Ltd. (“Camtek”) as a responsible person for day-to-day maintenance, I understand English and I understand the language and words in this Declaration. I am offering this Declaration in Support of Camtek’s Motion to Vacate Default Judgment.
2. My daily duties as an employee of Camtek include procuring Camtek’s mail from the Migdal Haemek Post Office, and delivering it to Camtek’s headquarters. Upon returning to Camtek’s headquarters, I deliver the mail to receptionists.
3. I do not recall receiving any envelope or package from the Israeli Central Authority on or about January 6, 2011. I would have remembered such a package. Although it is possible that I picked up the mail on January 6, 2011, I did not pick up a package from the Israeli Central Authority on that day.
4. I have reviewed the Certificate of Service attached as Exhibit 7 to the Magnuson Declaration. I do not recognize any signatures on the document as my signature. Attached as Exhibit 1 are representative samples of my signature when signing for

postal deliveries, invoices and other similar documents. The signature contained on Exhibit 1 are nowhere to be found on the January 6, 2011 registered mail receipt as revealed in the comparison below, with my purported signature on the left, and examples of my true signature on the right:



5. Plaintiff's speculation that I intentionally changed my signature on the document from the Central Authority is false. Documents from any governmental authority to Camtek are treated with high importance, but I am not aware of the specific contents of packages from the Israeli Courts or Central Authority.

6. I have never been advised by Camtek to change my signature or take any other action to defeat service, nor would I ever make any attempt to mislead by providing a false signature.
